## Summer Arts Camp 2017

July 17-20, 24-27

**What is it?** LUMC Summer Arts Camp is a two-week program with emphasis on visual and performing arts. (Art, Music, Drama, Movement)

**Who is it for?** The camp is open to children ages 6-12 (as of July 1)

**How much does it cost?** There is a \$65 supply fee per camper with a maximum of \$95 per immediate family, regardless of number of participants.

**Who will be teaching?** Instruction will be by Virginia licensed teachers and their supervised volunteers.

**What are the hours?** The camp will run from 9:00 - 3:00 Monday - Thursday for the two weeks. **The final performance, July 27th at 7:00, is a required part of camp.**

**Can I participate for only one week?** Unfortunately not. We will be working toward our final performance and all of the rehearsal time will be required.

**What about lunch?** Plan to bring a bag lunch daily. Drinks and dessert will be provided. If you have a situation where you can't bring a lunch, please notify the staff in advance so that lunch can be provided.

**Is there a closing program?** Yes! On July 27th, we will have a closing program beginning at 7:00pm. There will be a social time following the performance.

**How can I attend?** Complete the application! Attendance will be first come-first serve based on the age groups. Maximum participation is 36. (Twelve per age group: 6-7, 8-9, 10-12)

**How can I help?** You may contribute to the camp through a donation with the notation "Arts Camp". Also, volunteers are needed to help with supervision, snack time, and morning supervision during arrival time.
